Prof. Dr. med. Oliver Pfaar is currently holding the position of head at the Section of Rhinology and Allergology at the University Hospital, Philipps-University Marburg, Marburg, Germany. His clinical and experimental focus is mainly on inflammatory airway-diseases. He is also M.D. and specialist for Otorhinolaryngology with (sub-)speciality in Allergology. He has board certification in otorhinolaryngology (ORL, 2004) and allergy (2007).

After finishing medical school at the University of Göttingen, Germany, he was trained in ORL at the University Clinic of the Carl-Gustav-Carus Universität in Dresden, Germany. Besides, he is member of the board of Directors of the German Society for Allergology and Clinical Immunology (DGAKI).

Pfaar has been involved in more than 210 clinical trials in airway-diseases with many of those as global or country investigator and lead investigator at site. Besides, he acts as Associate Editor of Allergy, the scientific journal of the EAACI (IF=14.7).

Further, he has published 418 scientific articles in peer-reviewed medical journals and edited and authored multiple textbooks. He coordinated or has been involved in many international and national guidelines in allergy. His current H-Index is 63 with 13255 citations (SCOPUS June 2022). Pfaar has received multiple scientific awards such as the "Research Grant of the DGAKI" in 2019.
