Dr. Rothenberg is the Director of Allergy and Immunology at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center, a Professor at the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine, the Founder and Director of the Cincinnati Center for Eosinophilic Disorders, the Founder and Director of the NIH's Consortium of Eosinophilic Gastrointestinal Disease Researchers and the incumbent of the Bunning Chair of Allergy and Immunology. He has published over 500 peer review articles that have garnered >50,000 citations, an H-index of >130, and laid the foundation for therapeutics that are advancing the allergy/immunology field including the first drug approval by the FDA for eosinophilic esophagitis. He is a member of the National Academy of Medicine.
